Then there is the woman who disagrees with Black people doing a boycott because we apparently rank seventh on the list of those who have benefitted by DEI policies (after white women, Hispanics, Asians, white men, Native Americans, and the LGBTQ folks. I do know that when I interviewed a person not long ago about looking out for ANYONE who has faced discrimination, her response was that her Shoals Diversity Council was focused primarily on LGBTQ. Gotta admit that took me by surprise, given the history we Black people have faced in this country. While I don't want anyone to be discriminated against ever, the challenges that Black people face are unlike those of any other group. That's why I am reluctant to lump us in with everyone else when we are fighting to be respected and protected. All that said, I will definitely be participating in this boycott with my people. Tori
